Case 1 Therapy for Subdeltoid Bursitis, Acute or Subacute

Treatment	Time Minutes	Specifications	
Short wave diathermy Massage Exercise	20 10 10	Coil or drum, right shoulder Light or deep stroking and kneading to right shoulder Relaxed passive; active and assistive: graduated as to tolerated, attempting normal range; shoulder wheel and ladder, when tolerated	

Treat twice a day; physician to be seen after two days.

Instructions: (1) heat lamp thirty minutes twice a day for home use; (2) Codman exercises.

Case 2 Therapy for Colle's Fracture Five Weeks After Reduction, with Shoulder and Hand Stiffness

Treatment	Time Minutes	Specifications
Hydrotherapy	30	Whirlpool bath, water temperature 110 ° F right arm and hand
Massage	10	Deep stroking and kneading, right hand, elbow and shoulder; friction: wrist and fingers
Exercise	10	Active and assistive: attempt normal range, hand, elbow and shoulder; moderate forcing to shoulder and fingers

Treat daily for two weeks; physician to be seen after one week.

Instructions: (1) contrast baths for hands; (2) active hand and shoulder exercises daily at home.

Treat daily; physician to check every other day.

Treat three times weekly; total number of treatments, 15; recheck every two weeks
